part and the Riverton Cemetery Company in the County of Pictou a body corporate by the laws of the Province of Nova Scotia of the other part Witnesseth that the said John McEwan and Sarah B McEwan for and in consideration of the sum of five Dollars lawful money of Canada to them in hand well and truly paid by the said Riverton Cemetery Company in the County of Pictou the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged as and each of them doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said the Riverton Cemetery Company in the County of Pictou and their assigns all that certain lot of land situate at Riverton aforesaid and which is bounded and described as follows Beginning on the north side line of the lands of the said John McEwan at the south eastern angle of the Riverton Cemetery lot (as called) thence to run south five degrees west twelve feet to a stake thence north eighty five degrees west parallel with said McEwan north side line eleven rods and nine feet to a stake placed at a point at right angles with the south western corner of the said present Cemetery lot thence north five degrees east twelve feet to said Cemetery corner thence south eighty five
